

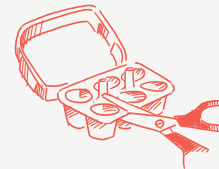
Counting sensory bin!

This counting carrots sensory activity is a great way for your little one to practice counting by matching the numbers together. Babies love interacting with the rice - it stimulates their senses.

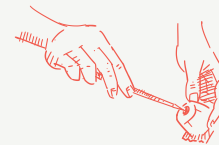

What to do:

Step 1
Cut your egg carton to split all the segments.



Step 2
Create a hole in the bottom of each segment that will allow the carrots to slot in.



Step 3
Paint the segments green and number each segment 1-12.



Step 4
Now number each of the carrots 1-12.



Step 5
Fill your sensory bin (cardboard box or plastic box) with the rice.



Step 6
Place the cartons in the sensory bin, upside down, with the cut-out slots at the top.

You will need:

- Green-dyed rice
- A 12-egg carton
- Green paint
- 12 carrots
- Felt-tip pen
- Cardboard/plastic box
- Tools, such as spoons, bowls and jugs
